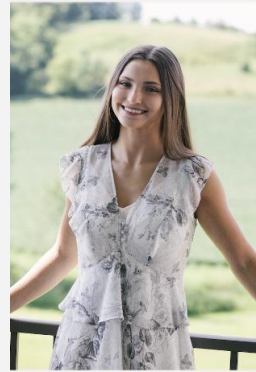

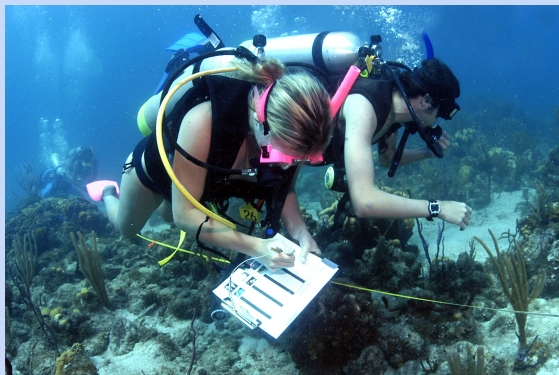

Wisconsin Boater Safety Course

In Wisconsin, anyone **born on or after January 1, 1989**, must successfully complete a boater safety course approved by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources in order to operate a motorboat or personal watercraft (PWC). Boaters are required to carry their boater safety course certificate as proof of boater education.
